Entree

STREAT is a not for profit social enterprise. We are fundamentally about helping marginalised young people make positive change in their lives and we do this by offering a range of programs to young people aged between 16-25 years who are at risk of, or experiencing, homelessness or who are otherwise disadvantaged.

Our programs aim to help young people stabilise their lives and we achieve this by improving their self-management and employability skills, and by helping them develop personal and professional support networks.

Eligibility & Suitability

The Entree program is free and available to young people who meet STREAT's core criteria:

- 16-25 years old
- homeless or at risk of homelessness
- otherwise disadvantaged

It is popular with a variety of young people, including:

- students already enrolled elsewhere in hospitality courses who need work experience to complete their qualification
- community school Year 10-12 students looking for some vocational exposure as part of their curriculum
- young people seeking a stepping stone to STREAT's Main Course, including those not already engaged with any training or education

Entrée does not include wrap-around support from STREAT's Youth Programs, so it is important that young people in this program have a responsible adult involved who is accountable for monitoring and managing the young person's attendance and supporting their engagement with the program.

Scheduling & Cost

Entrée is free and open to eligible young people on a continuous basis throughout the financial year.

A young person's individual needs are considered and a flexible and responsive schedule is developed in regard to hours per shift (2-6 hours); days per week (1-5 days); and weeks of engagement (1-13).

Application & Acceptance

STREAT Youth Programs staff will meet with a candidate and their support person to ensure that Entrée is the right program option for them, and to confirm that both understand the commitments and requirements involved. This meeting can occur before or after an application form is submitted.
