What should I say when the Census Collector calls?

Census Collectors will visit dwellings between Friday 29 July and Sunday 7 August.

The Census Collector will have a photo identity card and will carry their materials in a large yellow bag:



The Census Collector is likely to visit in the early evening or weekend, and will:

- Offer a Household Form or an eCensus envelope,
- Ask how many people will be here on Census night
- Ask for your name and a convenient time to return to pick up the completed Census form,

You should:

- Accept a Household Form from the Census Collector, (you do not have to give your name)
- Say that the number of people expected to be 'at home' on Census night will be six or less (even if there are more than six staying),
- Say that you will complete the Census form on the evening of 9 August 2011 and will return it by mail,
- Request a mail back envelope.

The Census Collector will not know that this is a Refuge
